

USA DIVING MASTERS HOSTING DOCUMENT

Revised 4/13/2005

According to the 2004-2005 USA Diving Rules & Code, M:3, 132.2. "The Spring Meet shall be held between April 1 and May 31. The Summer Meet shall be held between August 1 and September 30." All divers must hold a current USA Diving Athletic Registration Card, which must be presented at time of registration at the pool/facility.

Hosting Document must be submitted to the National Masters Chairman to be considered for hosting one of our National Spring or Summer Meets. A written commitment from the Aquatics Director, or other position of highest authority responsible for the pool/facility, on the Hosting Facilities' letterhead providing all of the information and data listed below. The annual deadline for submitting the Hosting Document is July 31st. Please mail the original document to the following address:

- ❖ The dates committed for our USA Diving National Invitational Masters Championships (typically Thursday through Sunday, may be Saturday through Monday) Please make sure that the dates do not conflict with holidays or other diving meets, check the calendar on USA Diving's web site: **www.usadiving.org**
- ❖ Pool fees and/or rates
- ❖ Other charges or fees including parking fees or arrangements
- ❖ "Potential hosts must provide pool supervision and adequate medical care (or access thereto) for all practice and competition sessions. Such arrangements must be guaranteed in the meet application of every potential host." (USAD M:3 132.4)
- ❖ Signature and Printed Name
- ❖ Job Title, Address and Phone Numbers
- ❖ Signatory's Email
- ❖ The pool's web site address

With these commitments, divers will be able to vote at the meeting held in conjunction with the National Invitational Summer Masters Championships, for both of the National Invitational Masters Diving Championship meets for the following year. (USAD M:3 132.4) Divers must be present at the Summer Meet's General Meeting to vote. This will help divers plan and book their flights within a very long lead-time. Hopefully, more divers will be able to join us.
